Healthy Foods For Families



What is WIC?

WIC is a nutrition program that offers healthy food and nutrition advice to pregnant women, new moms, babies, and children younger than five years old.



WIC Provides:

- Checks to buy healthy foods at local stores, such as milk, cereal, cheese, eggs, and baby formula.
- Nutrition advice on improving your family's health by choosing healthy foods.
- Breastfeeding advice and support for pregnant women and new moms.



- Referrals to doctors, dentists, and other community services and programs that can help you and your family.

Who Can Get WIC?

WIC helps families with moderate and low incomes. Even a family of four earning as much as \$712 a week (\$37,000 a year) can apply. Families on Rte Care or Katie Beckett also may qualify.



WIC is for:

- Pregnant or breastfeeding women
- New moms with babies under six months old
- Babies
- Children under five years old

Fathers, grandparents, and foster parents can also apply for WIC for the children in their care.



Check the chart below to see if you qualify.

Family Income Before Taxes	
If your family size is:	You can earn up to:
1 person.....	\$349 a week
2 people.....	\$470 a week
3 people.....	\$591 a week
4 people.....	\$712 a week
5 people.....	\$833 a week
6 people.....	\$954 a week

Remember, your unborn child counts as a family member.

Income guidelines for April 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007

If your income changes each week, you still may be eligible. Call the Family Health Information Line at 1-800-942-7434 to see if your family qualifies.
